**** 2006 Louis Roederer Cristal Champagne, France**

The most famous of the Roederer wines, created in 1876 to satisfy the demanding tastes of Tsar Alexander II who insisted that Roederer reserve the houses best cuvee for him every year. To distinguish the cuvee the champagne came in a flat bottom, transparent lead crystal bottle. The brand was named after this precious material..silky texture and fruity aromas complemented by a powerful mineral quality with white fruit and citrus notes. Produced only during the best years when the 40 % chardonnay and 60 % pinot noir have attained perfect maturity. Cristal is aged for 6 years and 8 months.
